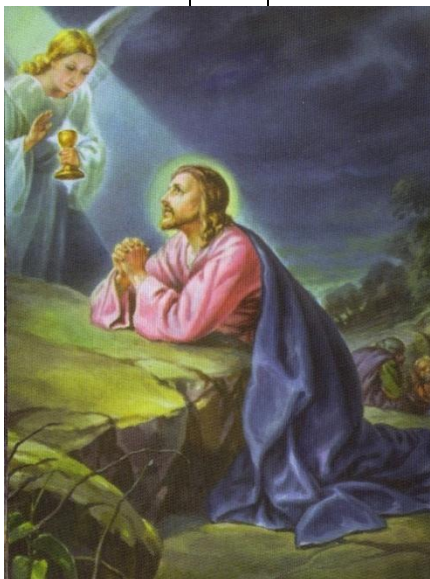

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

At every Divine Liturgy, you are invited to write the names of your living and deceased family members on the special forms in the office. The Brothers will take your list to the priests of our parish, who will remember during the Divine Liturgy. They will cut little pieces of the Holy Bread (Prosfora) for the health or for the repose of your relatives and friends. All of these little particles are put with the Lamb of God on the diskos. This symbolizes that the entire Church, in heaven and on earth, participates in the Divine Sacrifice. The list you have completed, together with an individual prosfora, will be put in the vestibule at the end of the Liturgy for you to take home. We welcome all of the faithful to pray together, remembering the words of Our Lord Jesus Christ: *"Where two or three come together in my name, there am I with them"* (Matthew 18,20), and also *"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you."* (Matthew 7,7) May the blessings of Our Lord be upon all of you and your families!
