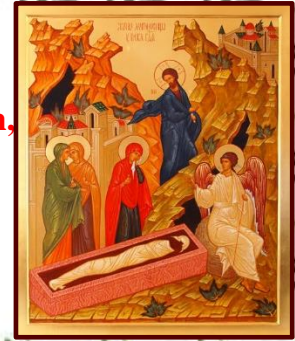

“Dear Fathers John & Michael and my parish family,

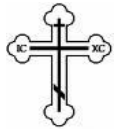
