FROM NOVEMBER 11TH TO DECEMBER 16TH
ST. HERMAN'S NEED LIST**

- Mayonnaise
- Coffee- regular ground and instant
- Sugar – 5 lb. bag
- Salad dressing – various
- Canned tuna and/or chicken
- Assorted canned meats (beef, chili, etc.)
- Assorted canned vegetables, fruits, soups
- Peanut butter
- Cooking oil

The St. Herman House - FOCUS Cleveland is an Orthodox organization exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, more specifically to manage the house of hospitality, promote the Orthodox ministry in the community, and help those in need in the Ohio City area.

FOOD

In the past year, they served over 73,000 hot meals. They are one of the only shelters in Ohio, and in the nation, that serves three hot meals a day, seven days a week, every day of the year. Additionally, the last five working days of every month, they provide grocery bags for women with dependent children. As a matter of course, as many as 800 bags of groceries will be distributed to over 250 families. As part of our hospitality outreach, they have available emergency food, bread, and pastries whenever needed. Also, they own and operate a 75-acre farm that they use in our farm-to-table initiative, and which is being developed as a recovery ranch for persons struggling with addiction.
